S.A.R.I. defines racially motivated harassment as:

Racial harassment is where an individual, group or their property is attacked because of their race, culture, ethnic origin or personal relationship with a person from another ethnic group.

The attack may be physical, verbal, written or psychological. It is up to the person reporting the attack, or the person receiving the report, to decide if it is racially motivated harassment.
